[INDO](#) focuses on found, reclaimed, and repurposed materials for all of their truly breathtaking vitrines, and this most recent installation is no exception. Made of salvaged polypropylene and vintage and dead [stock](#) fabric, the fluid, baroque display will be up until August in the Merchandise Mart for your viewing pleasure. We find the Jason Wu for Brizo sign especially cool — it's made of high density foam and strung on clear plastic rods so that it floats in mid-air. Our hats are off to these ladies and their beautiful work, and we can't wait to see what's next!
